

## Primary School Sport Funding – Review of 2015/16

Sports Premium is additional money given to schools to be used to raise participation in sports, competitions and encourage healthy lifestyles. At Birchanger School our overall aim is to ensure all children participate in high quality PE lessons, to broaden the PE and sporting opportunities offered to our children and to increase participation in sport and sporting competitions. We aim to develop the provision and quality of PE and School Sport in lessons and extra-curricular opportunities.

For the year 2015 / 16 the school has been allocated £8410

This year we will continue to use the Sports Premium Funding to further develop the quality and breadth of our sporting provision.
