

# Owls Class Curriculum Letter -Autumn Term 2- 2017

Please find information regarding this half - terms curriculum.

## English

Our focus remains on spelling, punctuation and grammar. We will start to use assessments so the children become familiar with the vocabulary used within test papers.

## Writing

We will be concentrating upon non-chronological reports, biographies and poetry. We will continue to use 'Talk for Writing' to aid the structure of the children's work. Please encourage the children to practise any story-maps with actions at home.



## Reading

The reading reward scheme will continue. Well done to the 18 children who received an award, last half term.

All children in Year 6 are expected to read at least **4 times per week! Please ensure that reading records are signed.** Children who fail to read at home will be expected to make up the time during their lunch hour.



## Maths

This half term we will be focusing upon multiplication, division, fractions and geometry.

We will be continuing with the timestable and division challenge.



## Science

We will be looking at the topic 'electricity'. The children will learn about the variations in how different components function. E.g. The brightness of bulbs. They will use the recognised symbols to represent circuit diagrams.

## Topic

We are going to focus upon locating countries, cities and oceans before moving onto economic activities, including trade links and the distribution of natural resources.

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## Art

Our artwork will revolve around our class book 'Alice in Wonderland'. Mrs Culpin has some wonderful ideas to bring the story to life!



## Computing

We are going to focus on coding and basic computing skills.

## French

French will be taught weekly by Mrs Allars. They will be learning about ma ville (My town)



## Physical Education.

Tom will continue to take the children once per week; this half term he will be teaching invasion games.

There will also be a dance sessions once per week. Our PE days are set for Tuesday and Friday, however, please ensure PE kits are in school all week in case of timetable changes. There are a lot of sporting competitions and tournaments planned for this half term.
